Hon'ble Prime Minister inaugurated Astol Regional Water Supply Scheme, Valsad, Gujarat



The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi Ji dedicated Astol Regional Water Supply Project to about 4.5 lakh tribal people from 174 villages and 1,028 hamlets in the hills of Valsad District in Gujarat on the 10th of June.

WAPCOS provided Project Management Consultancy Services including Proof Checking of Design, Bid Process Management and day to day Construction Supervision.

It was a challenging task to complete the Astol project in Kaprada and Dharampur talukas of Valsad district, but our engineers overcame all the hurdles. It's a technological marvel from the engineering perspective as well. Through this project, availability of water in hilly areas has been ensured by taking water to the height of about 200-storey building (1,875 ft.)

Hon'ble Prime Minister inaugurated Economically Weaker Sections Project under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana in Vadodara, Gujarat

This year on the 18th of June, the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated a housing project made for Economically Weaker Sections of the society under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) in Sayajipura, Vadodara.

WAPCOS had been awarded the Project Management Consultancy Services for PMAY schemes in Vadodara City at 11 sites including the one inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister in Sayajipura.

This site consists of six towers of seven stories each with 308 housing units with an area of 30 sqm each. WAPCOS carried out the layout plan, Cost Estimate, Preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) and approval from State & Central Authority, Tender Engineering and Project Management including day-to-day Construction Supervision and Quality Control.

In these housing units, infrastructure amenities like Solar System, Fire Fighting System, Lifts, Club house, Security Cabin, Street Lights, Roads, Garden with children play area, Lightning Arrester, Pump House & UG Sump, Bore well & Recharge well, Water Supply and Drainage System, Gas Pipeline Network are provided.

Inauguration of WAPCOS Executed Zero Liquid Discharge Plant and 'Amrit Tower' in Cochin, Kerala

The Hon'ble Union Minister of Commerce & Industry, Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution and Textiles, **Shri Piyush Goyal** inaugurated a Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) Plant on the 6th of June constructed by WAPCOS at the Cochin Special Economic Zone to promote the concept of Green SEZ. The capacity of ZLD Plant is 1 million liters per day and the treatment system includes Pre-treatment Unit, Reverse Osmosis (RO) and Reject Management System (RMS). The treated effluent from the ZLD Plant shall be reused for non-potable uses by various industries within the SEZ.

Along with the Zero Liquid Discharge Plant, the Hon'ble Minister also inaugurated the WAPCOS executed, 'Amrit Tower' in the Cochin Special Economic Zone. The tower with a built-up area of 1.83 lakh sq ft will facilitate young entrepreneurs in the emerging technology sectors.

PROJECT UPDATE:

Stung Sva Hab Water Resources Development Project, Cambodia



WAPCOS has been recently entrusted by the Ministry of Water Resources and Meteorology (MOWRAM), Government of Cambodia for providing the Project Management Consultancy Services for Stung Sva Hab Water Resources Development Project under the Line of Credit from Government of India

MOWRAM

Cambodia is predominantly an agricultural country and 85% of its population lives in rural parts of the country with agriculture as its main occupation. In this Asian country, agriculture production has been adversely affected by climatic hazards viz. floods and droughts, which are considered major problems for productive farming.

Due to significant rainfall and rich forest areas in Stung SvaHab River Basin, the basin has one of the richest potentials of water resource among all the river basins in the country, which can be used for irrigation and hydropower development.

The project will help to store excess water during rainy season, which will reduce flooding in the region. Moreover, the project envisages development of a small



Hydroelectric Power Plant which will contribute in meeting the energy requirements of the people in the region and people of Cambodia at large.

The salient features of the project include construction of a Gravity Dam and generation of hydropower.

Tasked with the Preparation of Detailed Project Report, Tender Engineering, Project Management Consultancy and Construction Supervision, WAPCOS has mobilised its team to Cambodia for commencement of the work and expeditious preparation of the Detailed Project Report. A joint site visit was conducted by the team of MOWRAM and WAPCOS.



PROJECT UPDATE:

Detailed Engineering Design and Supervision for Tranche 3, Ulaanbaatar Urban Services and Ger Areas Development Investment Program, Mongolia

Ulaanbaatar Urban Services and Ger Areas Development Investment Program is a long-term developmental project undertaken by the Government of Mongolia. The project comprises of three tranches of multisector interventions that support the Ulaanbaatar city master plan in upgrading priority infrastructure services and developing economic hubs.

The project's tranche 3 aims to promote an inclusive peri-urban development in Ulaanbaatar City's Ger areas located in the Western and Eastern parts of Ulaanbaatar, namely Tolgoit and Sharkhad. The project is financed by ADB, EIB and the Government of Mongolia. The executing agency is Municipality of Ulaanbaatar (MUB) and WAPCOS is responsible for providing Consulting Services, Detailed Engineering Design and Supervision.

The project will deliver direct benefits to the majority of residents in Sharkhad and Tolgoit subcentres and beyond. Approximately 49,900 residents within both subcentres are likely to receive direct benefits from the project every day and approximately 1,42,452 Mongolian citizens will receive indirect benefits. The number of direct beneficiaries will likely reach over 1,38,774 by 2040, whereas the number of indirect beneficiaries will go up to 2,85,967 by the year 2040.

A progress review meeting was held on 16th June regarding the review of the Detailed Design and finalisation of the procurement packages.



PROJECT UPDATE:

Concept-cum-Feasibility report for development of MICE Centre at Garhi Cantt, Dehradun



The Uttarakhand Tourism Development Board (UTDB) has taken a decision to develop a Meetings, Incentives, Conference & Exhibition (MICE) center at Dehradun to increase the tourism potential for the capital of the northern state.

WAPCOS was assigned the task of conducting a Concept-cum-Feasibility Report for the project by UTDB. WAPCOS completed the task of data collection, compilation and analysis of MICE related data at a city, region, national and international level. This has ensured adequate positioning of proposed project, with various allied products, on the National Tourism map.

MICE Centre will house Meeting halls, Breakout rooms, Conferences, Exhibition, Hotel, Retail, Sports and Entertainment development as a holistic development with Urban Forest led river front development. Study

and experience in the sector indicates that a majority of standalone convention facilities typically operate at a deficit and hence are not commercially viable. Therefore, in order to make this project a success, it has been proposed to include commercially profitable elements such as a hotel, spa, food and beverages components and real estate (retail space) as part of the project. The integrated development approach will ensure that the combined project is commercially and financially viable.

WAPCOS has also concluded that in order to ensure the success of the project and to derive optimum returns from the project for UTDB, it is advisable to develop the project on PPP format by involving a competent Private Sector Developer (PSD) and operator, selected through a Competitive Bidding process.



PROJECT UPDATE:

National Institute of Naturopathy (NIN), Pune, Maharashtra

aving been entrusted with the assignment for establishment of National Institute of Naturopathy (NIN), Pune Maharashtra by Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India, we are delighted to share that close to 88% of works for this project have been completed.

WAPCOS is responsible for detailed design engineering, procurement and construction i.e. from conceptualisation to commissioning of the project.

The NIN is conceived as an apex institution for naturopathy. It would aim at bringing a valid and useful synergy between established practices of naturopathy and modern tools and technology in modern health care. The institute will offer Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Doctoral courses in various disciplines of naturopathy and function as an international collaborative centre for global promotion and research in naturopathy. The institute will also be a centre with living Gandhi memorial offering 'Gurukul model' education with students, teachers and patients all staying at the same campus.

Establishment of National Institute of Unani Medicine (NIUM), Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh

The institute will offer Postgraduate and Doctoral courses in various disciplines of Unani medicine and also function as an international collaborative Centre for global promotion and research in Unani medicine.

The project comprises of a 200-bedded hospital, an Academic Building, Boys &

Girls Hostels (80 rooms - double occupancy each), Guest houses (17 suits), a Directors Bungalow, along with other allied works.

The project consists of a total plinth area of 58,500 sqm spread over 10 acres of land. As of June 2022, about 85% of works have been completed with an effective working



PROJECT UPDATE:

Preparation of Feasibility Study Report and Detailed Project Report for Sabarigiri Extension Hydro-Electric Project, Kerala

Rerala State Electricity Board (KSEB) has recently awarded the above work to WAPCOS. This includes obtaining all statutory clearances for Execution, including preparation of Bid & Allied Documents for selection of an Engineering Procurement and Construction (EPC) contractor for construction of Sabarigiri Extension Hydro-Electric Project.

The proposed Sabarigiri Extension Hydro Electric Project is located at Seethathode village of Pathanamthitta

district in Kerala. The project is envisaged to be a Conventional Hydro Electric Scheme utilising the water from existing Kakki Reservoir in addition to the existing operational hydroelectric scheme. The water conductor system will connect the Kakki reservoir to tail race exit through an underground power house.

The Contract agreement for the assignment between KSEBL and WAPCOS was signed on 24th May 2022 at KSEBL's office in Thiruvananthapuram.

A multi-disciplinary team from WAPCOS and KSEBL undertook the project site visit from 22^{nd} to 24^{th} May 2022. The

Team Visited the existing Sabarigiri Hydro Electric Project (340 MW) including the Kakki Dam and the Pamba Dam.

WAPCOS' Team is presently undertaking the feasibility study report and preparation of inception report is ongoing.

The total duration of the assignment is 22 months and it shall be completed by January 2024.
